



In the current situation, we would like to assure you that safety of our travelers, the crew on our ferries, and the ground staff, is our top priority. We comply with all State and WHO regulations.

Procedures and preventive measures used on Unity Line ferries:

1. Sanitary inspection in the form of temperature measurement before boarding (passengers / drivers with elevated temperatures are not allowed on board).
2. Disinfection of smooth surfaces and common facilities with increasing frequency.
3. Cabin disinfection after each journey.
4. Containers with hand disinfectants and gloves are available on ferries.
5. Containers with disinfectants disposed at every food court, reception, bar, crew's mess, shop.
6. Announcements regarding protection against covid-19 in public places on ferries.
7. An obligation to maintain at least a 2-meter distance between people in a public space.
8. Maximum 3 people per payment point in waiting areas and on-board stores.
9. The obligation to put on gloves before entering the store or food courts.
10. An obligation to maintain at least 1.5 m distance between work stations.
11. Hand disinfectants at the entrance to food courts, disposable gloves required.
12. Self-service has been limited- meals are being distributed by the crew members wearing disposable gloves.
13. The number of people in one room has been limited.
14. The number of people at a table has been limited, one table= one person.
15. Cutlery is protected with a food wrap.
16. Restaurants for passengers are closed.
17. Cabins: Polonia and Skania- single-berth cabins. Other ferries: up to 64 drivers- single-berth cabins, above- maximum of two persons.
18. An information about allocation of drivers on our ferries has been sent to forwarders we cooperate with. They have been asked to consciously make reservations and inform drivers about the latest restrictions.
19. Contact between deckhands and drivers has been limited.
20. The crew do not use elevators that are available for passengers (if necessary they use staircases)
